FANCY PLATE WITH BUTTERFLIES



MATERIALS

- Curvy Salad Plate BI301 • 3 Small Fancy Butterfly Tag-Alongs BI5006
- Sponge Small Flat Brush Large Flat
 Brush Small Round Brush
 Detail brush

• Paints: Plate - 16, 46, 92, 27 Butterflies - 3, 101, 16, 98, 92, 42, 31

TIPS

- Refer to photos for design placement.
- Butterfly tag-alongs should be painted individually. They can be glued to the rim of the plate after glazing and firing process is complete.

Color Me Mine

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe the bisque pieces with a damp sponge to remove ceramic dust.
- 2. Paint the center part of the plate with Pink # 16 using a large flat brush. Apply 3 coats.
- 3. Paint the rim of the plate with Yellow # 46.
- 4. Sponge the rim edges with Green # 27.
- 5. Dip the back of a small round brush handle into Yellow # 46 to make a dot in the center of the plate.
- 6. Make eight small brush strokes around the yellow dot as shown in the sample image. Use a small round brush and Purple # 92.
- 7. Make small purple dots around the edge of the pink portion of the plate where it meets the yellow rim. Use the back of a small brush dipped in Purple # 92.
- 8. Paint three butterfly tag-alongs with lighter color backgrounds and darker details. Finish each butterfly by painting its head and body with Black # 31 using a detail brush.
