## **COLORS**

CMM 31 - Licorice CMM 98 - Red Head CMM 57 - Squash Blossom SC 46 - Sunnyside Up

SC 48 - Guacamole

SC 85 - Oceanscape

SC - 41 Perfectly Purple CMM 7 - Blush

CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon

CMM 62 - Just Blue



## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use 2 coats of Just Blue to paint the outside of the mug.
- 2. While the outside is drying, paint 3 coats of Sunnyside Up on the inside of your mug.
- 3. When the outside of the mug is completely dry, use your marker to sketch on your candles. We started with a taller candle on the opposite side of the mug from the handle. Then there are 4 smaller candles on each side of the taller one. You should have 9 candles in all.
- 4. Paint in your candles in your desired colors with 3 coats of paint. We didn't do any of the candles with yellow since we will use that for the flames.
- 5. Paint in all the flames with 2 coats of Sunnyside Up and then put one dab of Squash Blossom toward the bottom of each flame.
- 6. While those are drying you can paint the handle with 3 coats of your desired color, we used Ocean Scape.
- 7. Finally, use your liner brush to make a messy outline on each candle and each flame using Licorice. We added a little water to the paint to help thin it down. We then used the same liner brush and Licorice paint to apply either dots or stripes to the candle.

## **TIPS**

- Three coats of paint will make solid colors that pop.
- The water based marker will disappear in the kiln, so don't worry if you make a mistake with it.
- If you want the dots to be the same size, dip the end into paint each time you stamp it down.
